- All Teams must be registered by July 10th
- All Teams may have a minimal of 7 players and maximum of 16 players
- This is a combined 7th and 8th grade league
- Teams may sign up for all three dates if desired
- Every Thursday before each game date. Your team will be notified the location of your game
- If you have more than one team entered on the same date, they will more than likely be playing at different venues to avoid playing each other

Cost

- \$75.00 per team – per weekend
- \$150.00 to enter your team for 2 dates offered
- \$225.00 to enter your team for 3 dates offered

ANSC 7 on 7 Youth Developmental Passing League

Anthony Newman Sports Camps (ANSC) is excited to announce its 1st annually 7 on 7 youth developmental passing league for athletes in 7th and 8th grade. The sport is growing across the nation, as more coaches, players and parents are discovering that 7 on 7 football is a great way for football players to enhance their skills and prepare players for their upcoming fall season. Many high school football coaches I spoke with over the years support the 7 on 7 league because it enhances the skilled positions. High school coaches feel that participating in the 7 on 7 leagues will get the kids one step closer for high school play. The ANSC youth 7 on 7 is a passing and receiving program designed to help develop the positions of a quarterback, running back, receiver, tight-end, linebacker, and defensive backs. There are no linemen, blocking, or tackling. The league will emphasize the passing game versus a variety of man and zone pass coverage. Each team can have maximum of 16 kids per team and a minimum of 7 kids per team. The teams are combined with 7th and 8th graders. We do not offer a league strictly for an 8th grade level or a 7th grade level.

ANSC Youth 7 on 7 Highlights

- Three dates offered: July 17th (Sun), July 24th (Sun) & July 31st (Sun)
- Game times are 4:00pm -6:00pm or 6:00pm-8:00pm
- QB-Tees with timers or shotgun snaps
- One hand touch (no blocking or tackling)
- 3 games guaranteed
- 15 Offensive plays and 15 Defensive plays per game
- 45 Offensive plays/45 Defensive plays in a 2 hour period
- East and Westside Venues

Cost

- \$75 per team - If you have a minimum of 7 kids on a team that's \$10 per child
- Cost is per weekend

****Teams must be entered by July 10th . No walk-ins allowed****

Note : Teams are not allowed to come together for practice prior or during the passing league. Focus is more on teaching than winning.

ANSC Youth 7 on 7 Developmental Passing League Rules

1. STARTING THE GAME

- A. Players are permitted to wear standard football cleats with plastic or rubber spikes. NO METAL
- B. Ball is always placed in the center of the field at the 40-yard line.
- C. The ball is not advanced. The ball is brought back to the 40 after each play.
- D. Each team will use its own ball during offensive possessions.
- E. Teams must arrive at least 15 minutes prior to start time. Teams must be on site, stretched and ready to play when scheduled. If a team is late offensive and defensive team plays will be deducted from their first game. IT IS IMPERATIVE TO KEEP TO THE TIME SCHEDULE.

2. MOVING THE BALL

- A. Offense always moves in the same direction.
- B. NO PASSER MAY RUN ACROSS THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE WITH THE BALL.
- C. All passes must be completed over the line of scrimmage. The only laterals that will be allowed will be laterals that occur after the completion of a forward pass.

3. OTHER RULES

- A. No blocking.
- B. Receiver/Ball carrier is legally down when touched below the neck with one or both hands.
- C. Excessive force by shoving, pushing, or striking a blow will result in player being expelled.
- D. Each team will have 90 seconds to snap the ball once it has been marked ready for play.
- E. The QB is allowed 4.0 seconds to throw the ball. A coach starts a stopwatch on the snap of the ball from center and stops the watch as soon as the QB releases the ball.
- F. Defensive coaches – 1 whistle, 1 sack count (1001, 1002, 1003, 1004 sack) **NO RUSH**
- G. Offensive coaches- in charge of getting plays off in a timely fashion and setting the pace.
- H. If a coach sees that the clock has exceeded 4.0 seconds, The play is blown dead
- I. Illegal contact – the responsibility to avoid contact is with the defense. There will be NO chucking, or deliberate bumping or grabbing.
- J. Interceptions may be returned but there's no blocking on the play by the defense.
- K. Offensive team is responsible for retrieving and returning the ball to the previous spot.
- L. Fighting: the player(s) involved will be ejected from the game and League. No taunting
- M. One coach is allowed on the field for the team's offensive possession. The coach must remain behind all offensive players at all times.
- N. One coach is allowed on the field for the team's defensive possession. The coach must remain behind all defensive players at all times.
- O. All games will halt until injured player(s) can be safely removed from the field).
- P. Not showing up can result in ANSC either not letting your team back into anymore of our league games or adding an additional fee to future tournaments that you sign up for.
- Q. **WEATHER CANCELATIONS:** If weather stops or cancels a league game, teams will be able to schedule another day to continue those games. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR WEATHER CANCELATIONS.

MOUTH GUARDS: It is required that mouth pieces be worn during games.

UNIFORMS: Teams may wear their team jerseys or wear a shirt that's the color of their school. All team members must wear the same color so it's clear who's on offense and defense.

(Example – If your team colors are Black and Orange, your team must pick one of the two colors to wear.)

IMPORTANT - PLAYER PARTICIPATION WAIVER: When you register your team, you will receive a confirmation email. In the email there is a link to our PLAYER PARTICIPATION WAIVER, which can also be found on the web site in the lower right corner of our Passing League page. Each player must have a parent sign the waiver in order to participate in our ANSC Passing League. **Coaches:** print out enough waivers for your team, have the parents sign them and give them to you **or** give a parent our web site link for the waiver form. The parent can print out the form, sign it and send it with their child to the game. Please bring these waiver forms with you and give to the ANSC field monitor before your teams participate in the games. After a parent has signed the waiver for their child, they won't have to sign another waiver. That waiver form will be good for that child the entire 2011 passing league season.
